Putnam Community Action Partnership (Putnam CAP) will award two \$500 scholarships to be used towards higher education, trade school expenses, vocational training or other work-force readiness preparation.

Ann Voss was a long time Advisory Board member for Putnam CAP. Her professional career as a nurse was cut short when she suffered a Traumatic Brain Injury in an automobile accident. Despite her disability, Ann worked hard to overcome her limitations and through her community work dedicated herself to helping others for the remainder of her life. Putnam CAP is proud to offer the Ann Voss Memorial Scholarships to two deserving individuals who are working to improve their situations through education and training.

To be eligible the applicant must be:

- Currently a registered Putnam CAP client.
- Enrolled in a school or training program as described above.
- An adult or graduating high school senior. (A high school diploma or GED is NOT required for adults.)

Applications Packet:

- A completed application form.
- A copy of enrollment in a college, trade school, vocational training or work-force readiness program.
- A typed essay of no more than 500 words.

Not required but will accept:

- A letter of reference from a teacher, instructor, or community leader.
